



Phone Card Information

Prepaid phone cards may be purchased in the lobby of the Kenton County Detention Center in \$5, \$10 or \$20 denominations between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and during visitation on Saturday and Sunday. Cards are passed out to the inmate population after dinner. If the card is purchased after 2 p.m., it will be delivered to the inmate the following day.

- The card is valid only at the Kenton County Detention Center.
- **No refunds** will be issued for a card that has been partially used.
